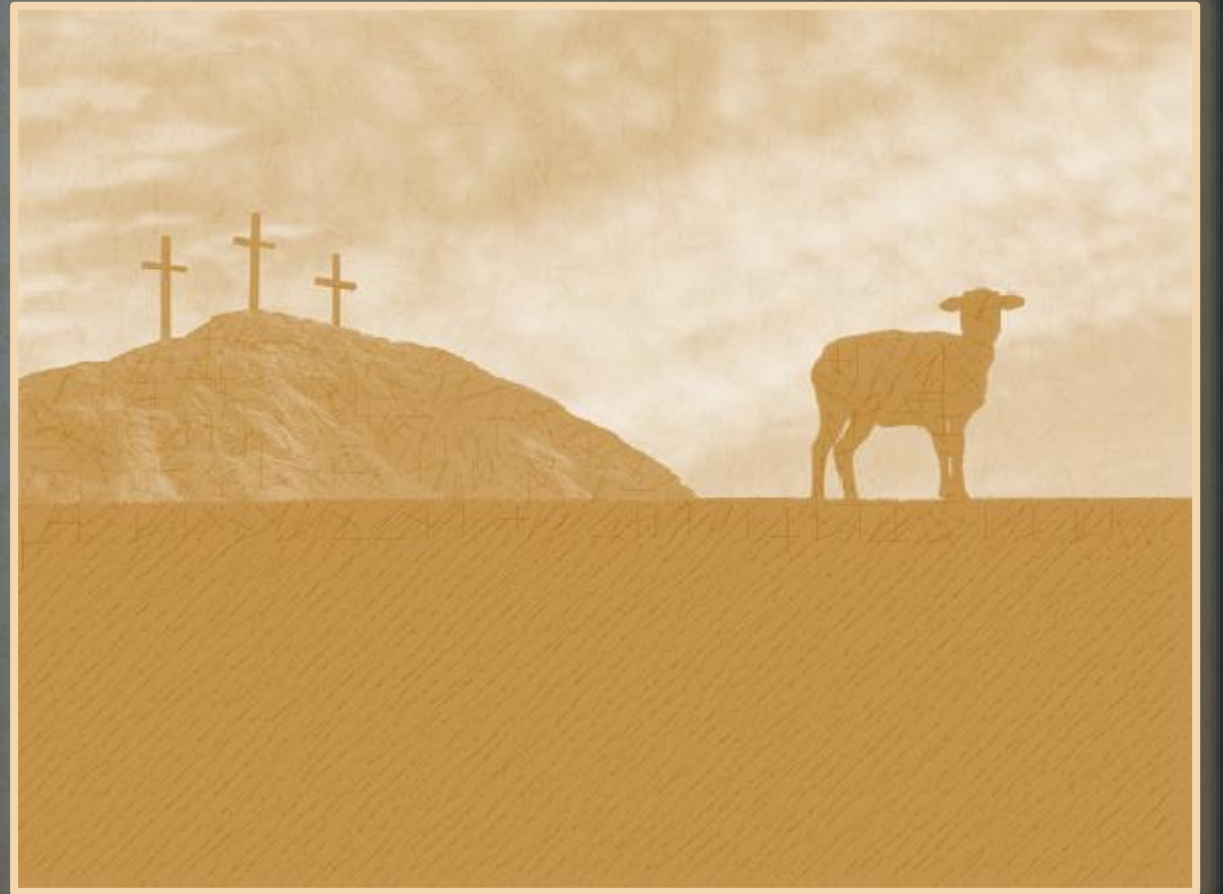


JESUS
